Autumn 1	Analysing Poetry (at least 10 poems) from AQA English Literature Anthology: Power & Conflict section. Assessment = Comparative essay	AQA English Language Skills: Paper 1- Creative Reading and Writing (of fiction texts) Assessment = Creative writing task
Autumn 2	Analysing a 19 th Century Novel: <i>A Christmas Carol</i> by Charles Dickens. Assessment = Extract question and a focus on the novel as a whole	AQA English Language Skills: Paper 2- Writer's viewpoint and Perspectives (with a focus on two non-fiction extracts) Assessment = Trial examination of Language Paper 1 and 2
Spring 1	Analysing a modern Drama text: <i>An Inspector Calls</i> by JB Priestley. Assessment = an analytical essay with students selecting from one of two questions	AQA Literature revision of <i>A Christmas Carol</i> and <i>Macbeth</i> + Revision of key areas of Language Paper 1 and 2
Spring 2	Analysing a Shakespearean play: <i>Macbeth</i> Assessment = Trial examination for Literature Paper 1 and 2	AQA Literature Revision of Power and Conflict poetry, Unseen poetry and <i>An Inspector Calls</i> + Language Paper 1 and 2 revision
Summer 1	Analysing Poetry (any remaining poems) From the AQA English Literature Anthology: Power & Conflict section + Unseen poetry Assessment = Unseen poetry essay	Bespoke revision and Exam Practice for Language and Literature
Summer 2	Recap and Revision of texts studied across the year with a focus on essay writing and exam skills. Non-examined assessment- GCSE Speaking and Listening (compulsory assessment task- will be filmed for the examination board)	Bespoke revision and Exam Practice for Language and Literature
