The Global Academy is an inclusive school and may offer the following range of provision to support children with SEND

Intervention

Access to a supportive environment – IT facilities/equipment/resources

- A range of ICT facilities IT facilities/equipment/resources
- LRC with computers Laptops
- Programmes to support learning: Mathswatch, Bitesize, Kerboodle.
- Programmes for assessment CAT's testing, progress tests in English and Maths
- The Bridge a calm environment for students that need a time out

Mentoring Activities

- Mentoring programme Y13/Y10 Mentors from outside school
- Daily Tutor Time Tutor groups for KS4 and KS5
- Progress leaders for each year group

Strategies and outside support

- Pencil grips, colour overlays.
- Specialist ICT software for identified students.
- Close liaison with home and school: attendance letters, Spotlight week reports, parent's evenings.
- Meetings with parents/careers to discuss support and strategies for removing barriers to learning.
- Teaching Assistants
- Support from outside agencies CAMHS, HACS, Hillingdon EP Services, Hillingdon Inclusion Team.

Strategies to support Literacy & Numeracy

- Support Group option at KS4.
- Intervention sessions before and after school.

Strategies to support modify behaviour

- Clear school policy and expectations of learning and behaviour.
- Whole school training
- Hillingdon EP services advice and support
- Strategy sheets for all students in on the SEND list. These are updated with parents/carers and students on a termly basis.
- Student 'Improvement Action Plans'
- Internal and external exclusions
