Year 12, 13 and 14 Uniform Policy

Key Stage 5 and Year 14 students are required to dress appropriately for a business, media industry professional working environment.

- No extremely ripped tops, jeans, short dresses, skirts or shorts
- No strapless dresses, tops or clothing with 'cut outs'
- No inappropriate, offensive words or logos on clothing or accessories
- No off the shoulder, cropped, belly, bralette, gym tops, shirts or jumpers
- No exposed cleavage, backs, bottoms, stomachs or underwear
- No low-slung trousers, tracksuit bottoms, shorts or jeans
- No flip flops or sliders
- No hoods up or outerwear should not be worn in class, workshops or lectures

Security/identification

All students are required to wear their lanyards and identification cards on site at all times. Identification photographs must show the full face. The identity of students can be verified at any time by any member of staff and students are expected to adhere to this request.

If students **do not** to follow the uniform policy, they risk being sent home and gaining an unauthorised absence on their record.
